

Danes Class Homework– Summer Term 2019

This half term, our history focus will be Leisure and Entertainment in the 20th Century. The children will be working towards preparing for a **final presentation** on their chosen aspect of Leisure and Entertainment. This presentation will include each child setting up a **display of their own learning and also giving a short oral presentation** to the class (2-3 minutes). The children will have three sessions in school to complete their project and should also complete some work at home each week. Children can choose from the following themes:

- Cinema and Film
- Holidays
- Television and Radio
- Toys
- Music

In order to create an interesting and engaging display, work should include a range of different tasks covering different curriculum areas. Some possible ideas are shown below. **All work should be in school by Monday 1st July.**

History An illustrated timeline from 1900 – 2000.	Design Technology A model of a relevant artefact from a particular decade e.g a toy or game, a radio, a cinema projector, a record player or an early caravan.	Art A piece of art work using any media e.g a painting of an album cover, a detailed pencil sketch of an old toy, a montage of pictures showing holidays through the decades, a poster advertising a film or a picture of some childrens TV favourites.
English/History Evidence of some research completed by interviewing a parent or grandparent. This could be in the form of a questionnaire or might be written up as a diary entry, recount or report.	Maths Some graphs or charts – perhaps showing some data collected for each decade e.g. cinema admissions or album sales.	Geography/History A map showing popular holiday destinations or locations of cinemas in the local area over the decades.
English/History Brief notes to assist with their oral presentation. Whilst a powerpoint can be used (perhaps for pictures), children should not simply read text from the screen)
