

#### Only One You Rock Display

We hope that you have noticed the lovely display of painted rocks next to the playground. The rocks were painted by all of the children (and adults too) on the class 'move up' day in July. We started the day with an assembly during which the book 'Only One You' by Linda Kranz was shared with the children. Children painted the rocks inspired by the pictures in the book. The wooden sign which forms part of the display displays important messages for us all to live by - these are also taken from the book. Our new Shackadell children will be painting their stones shortly and adding them to the display, as will any children who missed the opportunity in July.
