

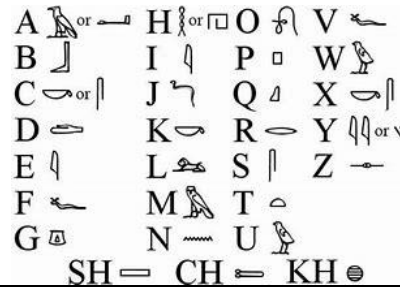
Danes Class Homework Projects - Autumn Term 2020

In order to support and enrich our learning in class, each child should choose one of the activities below linked to either our **'Awesome Egyptians'** theme or our work in science **'Animals including Humans'**. Once completed, this should be brought into school where it will be shared with the class. Children may prefer to use ideas of their own, or even wish to complete more than one of the activities below – we are very happy for the children to be as creative as they wish! Please make sure that work is completed and brought into school by Monday 14th December at the latest.

Make a poster about **The River Nile**.



Find out about **Egyptian Hieroglyphics** and have a go at writing (perhaps your name) using them.



Look up some **Egyptian Recipes** and choose one to make. You could bring the recipe into school and perhaps some photos. Alternatively, you could make an **Egyptian themed cake or biscuits**. You could, perhaps, bring something in to share!



Find a **photo of yourself as a baby and a recent photo**. Write down any similarities that you can see then think about all the ways that you have changed. You could show these on a timeline, in a chart organized by age or in any other format.



Design a **poster aimed at warning young people about the dangers of smoking, drinking alcohol or taking drugs**. Make sure that you create an eye-catching design and give a clear and memorable message.
