Can you make a poster about features of settlements which are essential, desirable and unwanted?  
E.g., water supply is essential, transport links are desirable, places prone to flooding are unwanted.

### Research:

-chester = castle -caster = castle -cester = castle e.g. Manchester	-ham = village -ton = farm -ford = river crossing e.g. Birmingham	-by = village -thorpe = farm -toft = house e.g. Scunthorpe
