In order to support and enrich our learning in class, each child should choose one of the activities below linked to our work in science (Evolution and Inheritance). Once completed this should be brought into school where it will be shared with the class. Children may prefer to use ideas of their own, or even wish to complete more than one of the activities below – we are very happy for the children to be as creative as they wish! Please make sure that work is completed and brought into school by Wednesday 23rd March at the latest.

Get creative and **invent your own animal!** You will need to consider its habitat and diet then make sure that it is suitably adapted to survive where it lives. Make sure that you label its adaptations.



Choose one of the **biomes of the World (terrestrial or aquatic)** and find out about the plants and animals that live there. You could present this as a poster, a Powerpoint presentation or in any other format.



Find out about **Jean-Baptiste Lamarck** and why he is famous. You could prepare a Powerpoint presentation or make a poster about him.



On Darwin's round-the-world trip on HMS Beagle, he visited many places including the **Galapagos Islands**. Create a fact sheet about the Galapagos Islands. Perhaps you could include information about what Darwin observed when he was there.
