# Spelling:

## Curriculum

In history this term, we will be studying the **Anglo Saxons**. Towards the end of the term, we will focus on the Geography topic of **Antarctica**.

**English**: we are beginning the year looking at Traditional Tales, particularly the story of Little Red Riding Hood.

Maths: Understanding place value and operations. Science: Animals, including humans.

**Computing**: Spreadsheets and effective French (Year 3): Core vocabulary and phonetics.
