Make a poster about **The River Nile**.

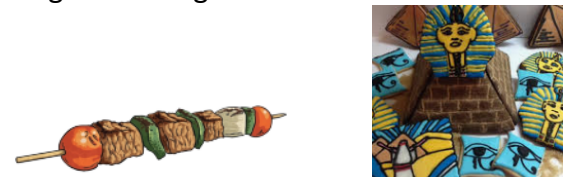


Find out about **Egyptian Heiroglyphics** and have a go at writing (perhaps your name) using them.



Look up some **Egyptian Recipes** and choose one to make. You could bring the recipe into school and perhaps some photos.

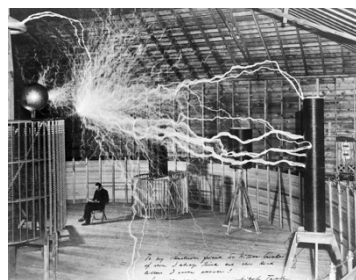
Alternatively, you could make an **Egyptian themed cake or biscuits**. You could, perhaps, bring something in to share!

Make a poster about **The River Nile**.

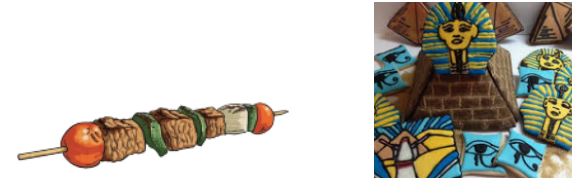


Find out about **Egyptian Hieroglyphics** and have a go at writing (perhaps your name) using them.



Look up some **Egyptian Recipes** and choose one to make. You could bring the recipe into school and perhaps some photos.

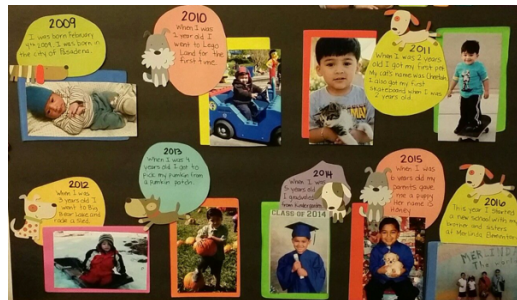
Alternatively, you could make an **Egyptian themed cake or biscuits**. You could, perhaps, bring something in to share!
