

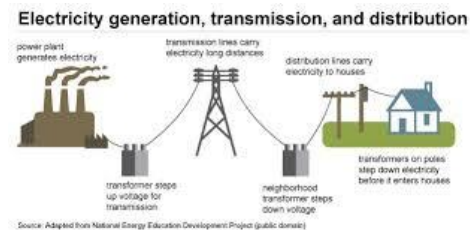
Danes Class Homework Projects – Spring Term 2023

Children may prefer to use ideas of their own, or even wish to complete more than one of the activities below – we are very happy for the children to be as creative as they wish! Please note that these projects are optional for Year 6 this term due to SATs preparation homework.

Make a poster or leaflet to inform people about the benefits of **renewable energy**.



Find out about how **electricity is generated and supplied to our homes**. You could produce a Powerpoint, write a report or produce a poster



At the supermarket or online, make a list of **where different foods are produced**. You could then show the information on a map of the world.



Design and make a **model space shuttle**.



Find out about the **planets**. You could make a booklet, a leaflet, some top trumps cards or a powerpoint presentation.



Listen to the work of **Gustav Holst – The Planet Suite**. You could produce some art inspired by one of the pieces, write about your favourite piece, compose a piece of your own to perform...or come up with an idea yourself!
