<p>Draw it</p> <p>Early Anglo-Saxons worshipped more than one god, like the Romans and Greeks. Each god represented different things, eg Woden-god of wisdom and Frige- goddess of love. Can you draw and write a brief description about your own Anglo-Saxon god?</p> <hr/>  <p>Woden, god of wisdom.</p>	<p>Make it</p> <p>As part of our learning, we will be visiting West Stow Anglo-Saxon village, can you recreate an Anglo-Saxon longhouse?</p> 
<p>Research and map it</p> <p>Where we are now was once part of the Anglo-Saxon kingdom. Can you research and map villages and towns in Hertfordshire and the surrounding counties (Bedfordshire, Cambridgeshire, Essex) that began during the Anglo-Saxons? Which of the seven kingdoms would Aston St Mary's been part of?</p>	<p>Write it</p> <p>Alfred the Great is one the most famous Anglo-Saxons in history. He was referred to the 'King of the English'. Can you create a fact file with key information about Alfred the Great?</p>
