Let me take this opportunity to welcome Mrs Brazier who will be our TA on Thursday and Friday mornings and Miss Dell, a student teacher, who will be in our class for the next eight weeks. I know that you will all make them feel as welcome as your children already have.

This half term we will be learning about lots of exciting new topics.

In History we are comparing and contrasting the lives of Queen Elizabeth I and Queen Victoria and in Art we will be looking at portraits and will create our own self-portrait.

In RE our learning question is 'Does praying at regular intervals help a Muslim in their daily life?' We will be looking at what it means by commitment and why people are committed to things.

In Science we are learning about 'Everyday Materials' where we will look at the difference between man-made and natural materials, their properties and their uses.

In computing we will continue our unit on 'Coding' where we are learning to write algorithms to make a computer program. We are also learning how to 'de-bug' programs that have errors.

In PSHE we will be looking at how to keep ourselves safe in different situations and how to deal with tricky situations and how to ask for help with more serious problems.
