<p>Think it</p>  <p>There's an expression 'as much use as a chocolate teapot'.</p> <p>Can you explain why would chocolate not be a good material to use for making a teapot?</p>	<p>Make it</p> <p>Make an object and material sorting game. You could ask an adult to help you find pictures online or draw your own.</p>
<p>Write it</p> <p>Choose an object made from one material and record all its properties.</p> <p>Eg. A window made from glass is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Transparent• Hard• Smooth• Waterproof	<p>Draw it</p> <p>We will be looking at recycling and why it is important. Can you create a poster encouraging people to recycle?</p>
