Visit the Roman Baths at Welwyn. You could write about your visit or produce a leaflet about them.



Find out about one of the following scientists:

- Alessandro Volta
- Mildred S Dresselhaus

You could produce a poster, fact file or PowerPoint about their life and work.



Produce a poster about Electrical Safety. Include as much information as you can and take care with presentation.



Invent your own electrical item that has not yet been invented! Explain how it would be used, with pictures and labels.
