Design your own island home, thinking about natural and man-made features. You could draw and label it or make a model of it. Make sure to add a key if you choose to draw a map.



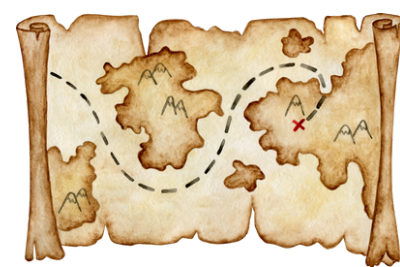
### Write it
