

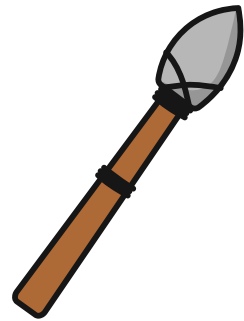

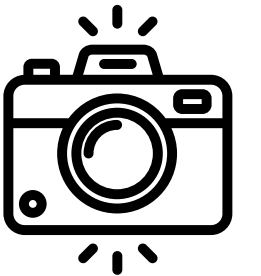
Make it

Stone Age people had to hunt and gather their food. In a safe space and with an adult, can you make a spear (maybe from a stick) or another hunting tool and act out hunting and gathering your food? Ask an adult to film you. Think about how you would reach high berries or fruit.



Write it

Imagine you are going back in time to the Stone Age and you can take one piece of modern technology with you. What would you take and why? Would it be a phone, a light bulb, a camera or something else? Write an explanation for your choice.



Create it

Can you write an acrostic poem using the words 'Stone Age'? Make sure you use the information about the Stone Age that you have learnt so far! Make sure you illustrate your poem too.



Design it

Can you use a picture of an Iron or Stone Age reconstruction and design an app around it? Put your picture in the middle of your page, number the parts you think are important and record your voice to give the information as if each one was tapped on an imaginary screen.
