Make it



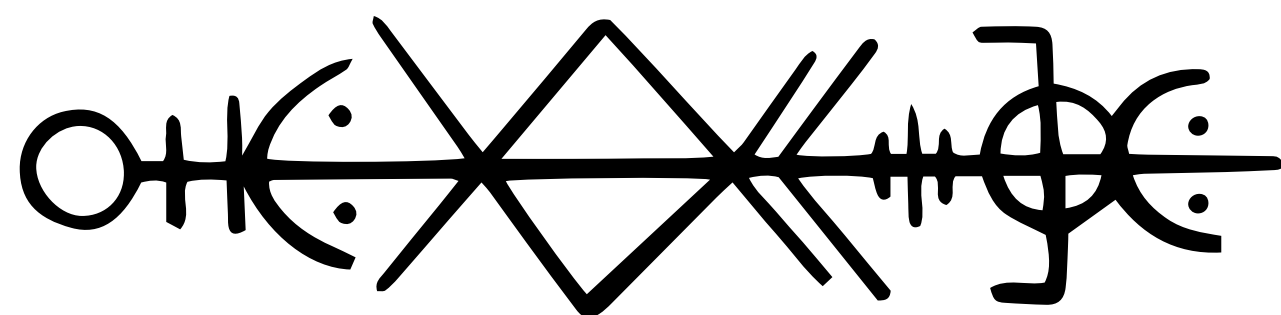
Make a 3d model of a Viking longboat. Think about the features of the longboats that we have looked at in class. Can you challenge yourself to make it float?
