

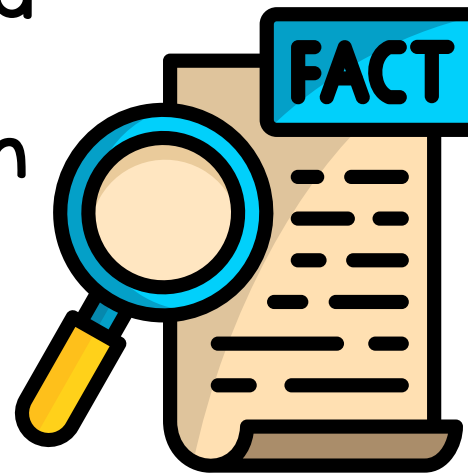

Design it

Design a fact file about an animal from the rainforest. As well as anything you find interesting, please include an illustration, a map showing where their rainforest is, an interesting fact and information about what they eat.



Research it

Research a tropical rainforest of your choice and create a three day weather diary. Include pictures and a description of the weather for each day. How does this weather compare to the UK? How does it impact the animals and plants there?



Make it

Make a rainforest in a box to show all four layers of the rainforest. Can you make and add animals? Use as many different recycling materials as you can and be as inventive and colourful as possible!



Create it

Create, draw or use a printed world map to show where all the tropical rainforests are. Add as much information to the map as you can such as the Equator, the names of the oceans, continents and countries that you know. You can make this as arty as you like!
