

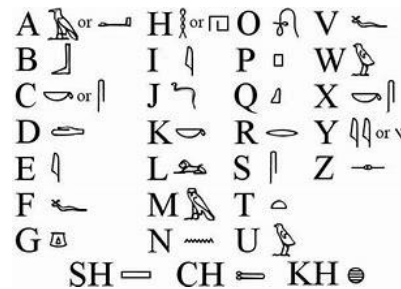
Year Four Home Learning Projects - Autumn Term 2025

Find out about **Egyptian Hieroglyphics** and have a go at writing (perhaps your name) using them.



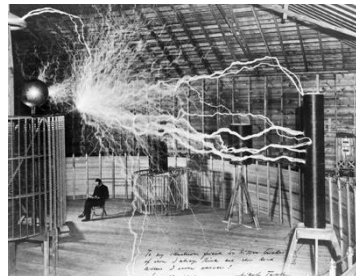

What can you find out about the electric eel? How did they get their name?



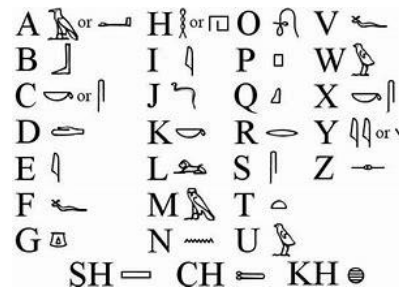

Find out about **Egyptian Hieroglyphics** and have a go at writing (perhaps your name) using them.

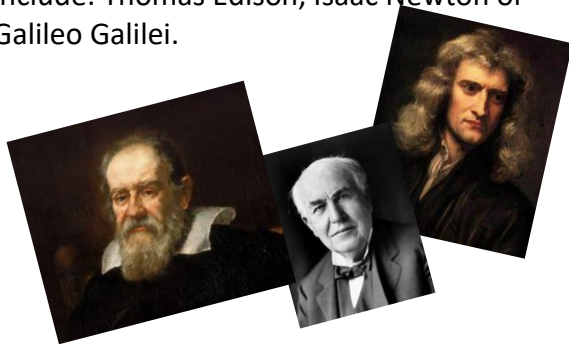


Look up some **Egyptian Recipes** and choose one to make. You could bring the recipe into school and perhaps some photos.
